

## **HPBA / NRDC Mtg on Gas Efficiency**

At the request of the Department of Energy (DOE), HPBA staff, volunteers and attorneys met on August 26 with the environmental groups who have challenged HPBA's opposition to DOE's final rule regulating gas fireplaces. The purpose of this meeting was to educate the groups – the National Resources Defense Council (NRDC), the American Council for an Energy-Efficient Economy (ACEEE) and Earthjustice – on decorative gas appliances.

HPBA's presentation focus was that 1) decorative gas fireplaces account for a small fraction of residential gas consumption; 2) heat efficiency standards for decorative products would cause product substitution, not energy savings; 3) heater-rated products only should be subject to heat efficiency standards; and 4) decorative products are not heaters and should not be regulated as such.

There was also discussion on how to make a clear distinction between decorative and heater-rated as products as well as the devastating economic impact of the final rule on the gas product industry. While no substantive offers were made by either side, suggestions were discussed and all parties agreed to review them. ## **EPA Meets with Small Business Reps**

On August 25, HPBA's Small Entity Representatives (SERs) met with a panel of officials from EPA, the Office of Management & Budget (OMB) and the Small Business Administration (SBA). The Small Business Regulatory Enforcement Fairness Act of 1996 (SBREFA) requires EPA, when planning or amending a rule, to organize a group of representatives of the small businesses that would be affected in order to give them a chance to submit comments orally and in writing.

The SERs covered a variety of issues, but the overriding concern was the lack of time the manufacturers have to prepare for the levels of emissions reductions and the enormous financial burden on the smaller companies. In addition to the SERs, representatives from National Association of Home Builders (NAHB) and the Brick Industry Association (BIA) were present, as well as Timothy Seaton from Timely Construction, representing the masonry heater industry. ## **In-House Testing Lab Workshop**

On August 11, representatives from 12 HPBA companies met in Madison, WI, for a workshop, "Solid Fuel R&D Laboratories: How to Establish or Re-Establish a Company Emissions Lab." With the highly anticipated revisions

to the New Source Performance Standards (NSPS), many manufacturers are considering an in-house testing facility to meet the potentially stringent compliance time frame. The participants of the Intertek-sponsored workshop toured the EPA-approved test laboratory and heard several presentations on how to establish an in-house facility. Our sincere appreciation to Rick Curkeet and staff at Intertek Labs for hosting and providing the technical support.

## **Remodeling Trends Released**

According to the preliminary estimates by the Remodeling Futures Program, the remodeling market (including owner/rental improvements and owner/rental maintenance and repairs) was down in total spending by about 11 percent in 2009 compared to 2007, however, homeowner improvements declined 17 percent. Professionally-installed projects were down 15.7 percent compared to a 20 percent decline in D-I-Y projects.

Energy "green" remodeling projects, e.g. insulation, updating HVAC systems and windows, fell by only 5 percent. It is believed the government stimulus programs' tax credits and grants contributed to the smaller declines.

## **HPBA Board Forms Task Forces**

At its June meeting, the HPBA Board formed three task forces to evaluate operational procedures and structures as well as revenue growth as the economy improves. The Sales Process & Structure task force, chaired by Loretta Dolan, met August 26 at the HPBA office; the Long Range Vision task force, chaired by Tom Wenke, meets September 2nd in Chicago; and Harold Hudson is chairman of the Revenue Growth task force, which meets September 29 in Phoenix. The task forces will report to the Board at the October 26 meeting.

## **PFI Defends Boiler Industry**

The Pellet Fuels Institute (PFI) submitted comments to a rule proposed by EPA under the Clean Air Act. The proposed rule will affect emissions of hazardous air pollutants from institutional, commercial and industrial boilers and process heaters burning biomass and other fuels. The stringent hazardous air pollutant limits in this proposed rule will have significant cost impacts on biomass boilers, and it will also have the effect of discouraging the future use of biomass in these boilers.
